### **Inconceivable Theatre to launch Chekhov inspired comedy, “Three Sisters—Alone!” as inaugural production.**

Bedlam ensues when members of a fictional Canadian theatre troupe attempt to perform Chekhov’s “Three Sisters” despite ever-increasing obstacles in Inconceivable Theatre’s debut production, “Three Sisters—Alone!.” Adapted and directed by Inconceivable artistic director Joe Lehman, the farce follows five members of the Upper Manitoba Players as they struggle to recreate Chekhov’s classic with puppets, backstage conflict and unrequited love.

“Three Sisters—Alone!” is an engaging and hilarious work best described by Chicago’s own Belinda Bremner as “‘Noises Off’ on a gallon of espresso!”

“Three Sisters—Alone!” runs August 7-8 at 8 p.m. and August 9-10 at 7 p.m. at the North Lakeside Cultural Center 6219 N. Sheridan Rd. Chicago, IL 60660. All proceeds for the August 10 performance will go to support The Actor’s Fund. Tickets are \$10 and can be purchased online at [www.inconceivabletheatre.org](http://www.inconceivabletheatre.org) or in person just prior to the show. Advance purchase is recommended as seats are limited.

Street parking for “Three Sisters—Alone!” at the North Lakeside Cultural Center is available but extremely limited. Public transportation is recommended via the Red Line Granville stop or the 151-Sheridan buses.
